## About the Programme

The **Mediterranean Studies** programme of the Master in Advanced European and International Studies (MAEIS) is targeted at students who have completed their undergraduate studies.

The bilingual Master follows an original approach: the MAEIS is an **international, interdisciplinary and itinerant programme** which aims to educate the next generation of Euro-Mediterranean decision-makers. Following the motto "Learning and Living the Mediterranean", students rotate their place of study each term, moving from **Nice** to **Tunis** and then to **Istanbul**, including a study trip to **Dakar** and **Banjul**. Small class sizes enable students to actively engage with course material; our professors offer personalised advice as students conduct research and write their theses.

The MAEIS is a one-year-programme, subdivided into three terms. At the end of the academic year, students have the option to do a **professional internship**.

## **Overview of the Academic Year**

TERM 1 October to December The term in **Nice** focuses on European integration in order to analyse and understand Euro-Mediterranean relations. The courses present the institutional architecture of the EU and its neighbourhood policy, while addressing political, geopolitical, historical, economic and migration aspects of the EU. The term concludes with a workshop on international negotiations and a simulation game.

**TERM 2** January to April In **Tunis**, courses are devoted to analysing the processes of transformation in the Southern and Eastern Mediterranean in a globalised world, with a particular focus on the Maghreb. Studying in Tunisia, on the campus of our partner Mahmoud El Materi University, offer students a unique experience of a historic process of democratic transition, with its benefits and limitations. Students learn in an intercultural environment. From Tunis, they will travel to **Dakar** in Senegal and **Banjul** in Gambia.

TERM 3 April to Tune In **Istanbul**, on the campus of our long-standing partner Istanbul Bilgi University, students follow courses on Turkey's geopolitics, the evolution of its relations with the EU, the challenges of the sub-region, risk management, populism and minorities. They also take part in a project management workshop. The programme concludes with the defence of the thesis and the final oral exam.

Internship option Students who choose the internship option will pursue the programme by doing a professional internship of 3 to 6 months.

## Study Trip to Dakar and Banjul

One of the best ways to understand the Maghreb in the context of Africa is to visit another region of the continent: Sub-Saharan Africa. During an extended study trip to **Dakar, Senegal** and **Banjul, Gambia**, students will have the opportunity to delve deeper into the topics of development and inter-African migration.

They will attend classes on the campus of our partner Groupe Supdeco and exchange with a variety of local and international actors.

#### Recent activities include:

- Meeting with the EU Ambassador to Senegal
- Round table on Europe-Africa relations
- Visits to NGOs focusing on development challenges (hunger, education, health)
- Discovery of Gorée Island and its slave house
- Workshops on diplomatic negotiation techniques



## **Tuition and Scholarship Funds**

Tuition fees cover not only academic teaching throughout the year, but also include among others:

- the students' accommodation in Tunis
- the programme-related travel expenses
- the study trip to Dakar and Banjul

A limited number of scholarships is available for qualified candidates who are unable to cover the cost of their studies.

# **Admission Requirements**

- → A completed first degree (minimum three years of study at university level)
- → Active knowledge of English and French

#### **DEGREE AND RECOGNITION**

Graduates are awarded two certifications:

- Master in Advanced European and International Studies: This is the diploma of CIFE as a private institute of higher education, certifying the successful completion of the academic curriculum and granting 60 ECTS credits at Master level.
- The degree qualification Policy Officer in European and International Organisations is recognised by the French state as a degree at Master level (level 7 EQF).



## **Career Prospects**

Graduates of this programme work for European institutions, international organisations, non-governmental organisations, national diplomacy, consultancies, research institutes as well as for the private sector. The programme equips them with the necessary knowledge, skills and competences required on the job market of international and European organisations. Since its foundation in 1954, over 5000 students from more than 120 countries have graduated at CIFE.
